As an emerging theme of the World Humanitarian Summit held in May 2016, Mr. GUERRERO SALOM, Standing Rapporteur for Humanitarian Aid (European Parliament Committee on Development) and the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) are co-organising a Panel Debate focusing on **Protracted Conflict and Humanitarian Action** with the participation of DG ECHO and DEVCO (tbc).

Protracted conflicts are a major source of human suffering, and a cause of protracted displacement, migration and development reversals. Based on the ICRC [Report](#) issued in September 2016, the discussions aim at exploring issues related to the relief -development relationship and the urbanisation of humanitarian response, as well as multi-year planning and humanitarian financing.
