As an emerging theme of the World Humanitarian Summit held in May 2016, Mr. Enrique GUERRERO SALOM, Standing Rapporteur for Humanitarian Aid (European Parliament Committee on Development) and Mr. Walter FUELLEMANN from the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) are co-organising a Panel Discussion focusing on **Protracted Conflict and Humanitarian Action** with the participation of Mr. Jean-Louis de BROUWER of DG ECHO and Ms. Maria-Manuela CABRAL of DG DEVCO. The discussion will be moderated by Mr. GUERRERO SALOM.

Protracted conflicts are a major source of human suffering, and a cause of protracted displacement, migration and development reversals. Based on the ICRC Report issued in September 2016, the discussion aims at exploring issues related to the relief -development relationship and the urbanisation of humanitarian response, as well as multi-year planning and humanitarian financing.
